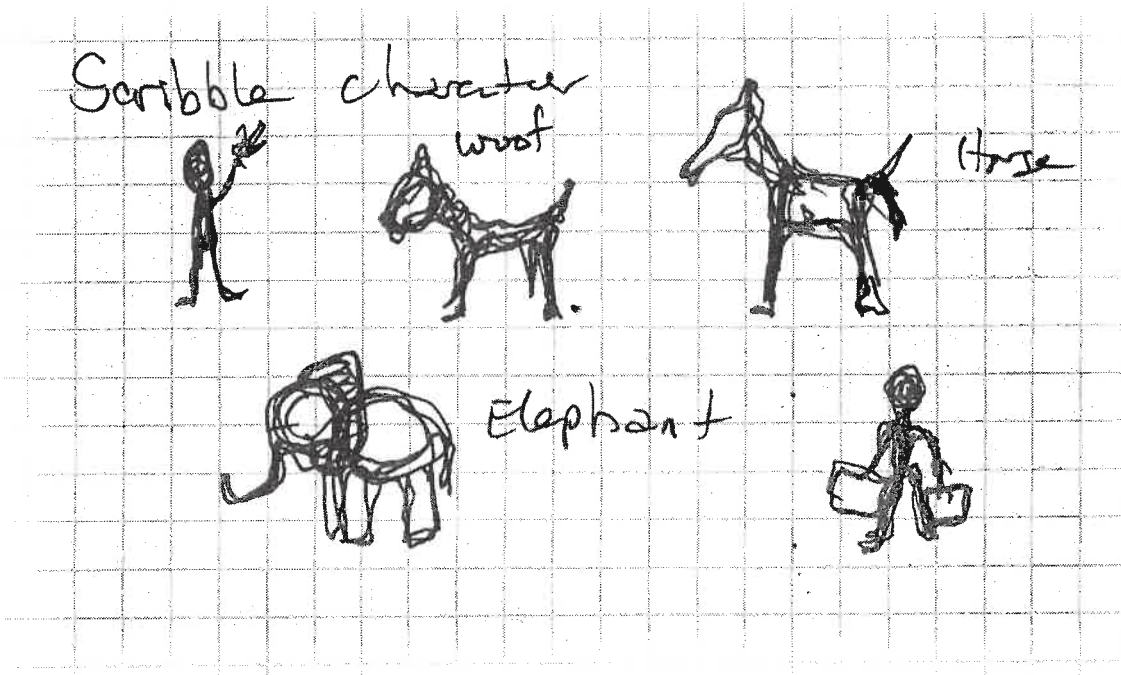


## Scribble Characters



Scribble drawing is like modeling in clay. A stick figure takes the place of the sculptor's armature. When we build on this by adding scribble to scribble until the sketch is done. Try to think like a sculptor and to visualize each scribble as a three-dimensional mass rather than a flat mark on the paper. Unlike clay, however, these masses can be pushed into each other.

There is no set rule about the forms of the scribbles. Nevertheless, you might find it easy to start with a very simple line and start thickening from there. Try a couple from the following list

- ① Pick 4
- Man
  - Woman
  - Dog
  - Horse
  - Elephant
  - Camel
  - Twitter bird
  - Whale
- ②  the selected 4
- ③ Create the symbol below
